### Qualifications

- Adult men & women
- Enjoy Interacting with people
- Enjoy setting up light refreshments and engaging in conversation
- Friendly, dependable, service-oriented

### Commitment Time

- 30 minutes before and 45 minutes after Mass
- Occasional events
- 1-year time period
- One-time ministry general orientation

### Basic Responsibilities

- Set up the coffee/ and any other refreshments to be used prior to the end of Mass or start of event
- Cheerfully interact with guests
- Clean up the area at the conclusion

### Shifts (when to arrive)

- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to Mass/event
- Saturday 4:00 PM Mass: 3:30 – 5:45 PM
  - Sunday 8:30 AM Mass: 8:00 – 10:15 AM
  - Sunday 10:30 AM Mass: 10:00 – 12:15

### # of Ministers Needed

- Minimum of 1 minister for each Mass or event, if possible
- Ideally, 2 ministers for each Mass
- No maximum
