Overview of Ministry

Gather and engage in teams of prayer who pray the Rosary in various settings and for various purposes. Some settings include funerals, before Mass, or in a community setting.

Qualifications

- Adult men & women
- Committed to Christ
- Feel called to prayer
- Dependable and Accountable

Commitment Time

- Approximately 30 minutes to 1 hour for each occasion
- Participate in whichever groups of Rosary teams you feel inclined
- 1-year time period
- One-time ministry general orientation

Basic Responsibilities

- Prayerfully recite the Rosary as a group for whichever event(s) you can join

Shifts (when to arrive)

- Varies, according to needs
- For funerals and special events, the Team Leader will contact with the day and time
- For Mass Rosary, arrive at least 40 minutes prior to Mass

of Ministers Needed

- Minimum 2-3 for each group
- No maximum
