

UNBOUND INTERCESSORS

Overview of Ministry

Unbound intercessors assist a person through the process of healing using the Unbound Model of five keys. The intercessors pray silently during the Unbound session while the Leader takes the person through the five keys.

Qualifications

- Adult men & women
- Committed to Christ
- Feel called to prayer
- Dependable and Accountable

Commitment Time

- Varies, depending on need – sessions last anywhere from 30 minutes to 2 hours, dependent on the situation, the time allotted, and the Leader
- 1-year time period
- One-time ministry general orientation

Basic Responsibilities

- For individual sessions, pray silently for the person and the session while sitting near them during the telling of their story and while the Leader is guiding them through the five keys
- For group sessions, attend the lecture and form into small teams to pray for the person in the session – these are shorter sessions, giving opportunity for several people to have a session

Shifts (when to arrive)

- Varies, depending on need – sessions last anywhere from 30 minutes to 2 hours, dependent on the situation, the time allotted, and the Leader
- Individual sessions are normally scheduled as needed, with occasional group Unbound sessions

of Ministers Needed

- 2-3 per session per team
- Extra ministers may pray outside the session for the person
- No maximum
