## Overview of Ministry

## Qualifications

- Adult men & women with the ability to sing
- Ability to follow directions
- Friendly, dependable, service-oriented, follow direction

## Commitment Time

- Duration of Mass plus 30 minutes prior
- Choir rehearsal for 1 hour as scheduled (usually on Wednesday evenings at 7:00PM)
- 1-year time period
- One-time ministry general orientation

## Basic Responsibilities

- Attend choir practices as scheduled
- Practice on your own as necessary
- Follow the direction and guidance of the Director of Music
- Being punctual and prepared
- No talking or chatter before or during Mass
- Being dependable

## Shifts (when to arrive)

- Arrive at least 30 minutes prior to Mass/event
- Saturday 4:00 PM Mass: 3:30 – 5:00 PM
  - Sunday 8:30 AM Mass: 8:00 – 9:30 AM
  - Sunday 10:30 AM Mass: 10:00 – 11:30

## # of Ministers Needed

- Multiple Choir ministers for each of the 4 Masses (minimum 1 Cantor per Mass)
- No maximum
